RELEASE OF LIABILITY: READ CAREFULLY – THIS AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

I understand and agree that my access to the Picatinny Arsenal Family and Morale Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Archery range is a privilege. I agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Archery Range Policy published 1 June 2026. I understand that failure to comply with the Policy will result in revocation of access privileges.

By signing below, I express understanding of, and agreement to the following:

- All current authorized patrons defined by AR 215-1, Army Military Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Programs, approved by the Garrison Commander, and over the age of 18 may access the Archery Range. Patrons 17 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- By accessing the facility, I agree to report any misuse, abuse or violations of the Archery Range policies to the Picatinny Police and MWR Management.
- I am not permitted to have guests in the facility.
- There will be no supervision or assistance offered during unmanned hours, and I am expected to adhere to all MWR and Archery Range regulations, policies and rules. Violations of these regulations, rules, or policies will not be tolerated. I am responsible for my conduct.
- I agree to sign the logbook upon entry to the Archery Range.
- Holding or propping the door open is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate loss of my privilege.
- For safety and security, I will ensure the front door securely closes following my entry. All other doors WILL remain closed unless needed for an emergency.
- Areas that are not available for use will be locked or clearly marked as restricted.
- I will not participate in horseplay or other activities that may be offensive or jeopardize the safety of others or myself.
- Equipment must remain inside the Archery Range and will not be taken outside of the facility under any circumstances.
- I will identify and assess potential risks before engaging in any activity and will take reasonable precautions to mitigate risk of injury.

LIABILITY WAIVER:

- In consideration of access to the Archery Range and use of the equipment and facilities provide by MWR, I expressly agree and contract, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, that MWR, United States Army and United States Government, and its insurers, employees, officers, directors, and associates, shall not be liable for any damages arising from personal injuries (including death) sustained by me, or my guest in, on or about the premises, or as a result, in whole or in part, from my voluntary use of the Archery Range and participation in archery activities within the facility. I understand and acknowledge that Archery and the equipment used for participation has inherent risks and dangers, which include the risk of personal injury, property damage or death, which include risks associated with the use of bow and arrow, accidental discharge of a bow, or ricocheting arrow projectiles or fragments thereof. By the execution of this agreement, I accept and assume full responsibility for any and all injuries, damages (both economic and non-economic), and losses of any type, which may occur to me, and I hereby fully and forever release and

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discharge Family and MWR, United States Army and United State Government, its insurers, employees, officers, directors, and associates from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action, or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known or unknown , anticipated, or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out the use of said equipment and facilities. I expressly agree to indemnify and hold Family and MWR, United States Army and United States Government harmless against any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action, of any person or entity, that may arise from injuries or damages sustained by me. I agree to be solely responsible for safety and well-being of myself. Initial: _____

- I understand the Archery Range does not provide supervision, instruction, or assistance for the use of the facilities and equipment during unmanned hours.
- I agree to comply with all rules imposed by MWR regarding the use of the facilities and equipment. I agree to always conduct myself in a controlled and reasonable manner, and to refrain from using equipment in a manner inconsistent with its intended design and purpose.
- I understand and acknowledge that the use of the equipment involves risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death.
- I understand and agree that the MWR is not responsible for property that is lost, stolen, or damaged while in, on, or about the premises.
- I understand and agree that my use of the facilities and equipment is only to be undertaken on my own personal time, and that my use of the facilities and equipment is not within the course or scope of my employment
- PRE-EXISTING MEDICAL CONDITIONS. I represent that I am in good physical health and have no symptoms, medical conditions, impairments, or diseases that might be aggravated, worsened, or induced by my intended use of the Archery Range. If I have any health or medical concerns now or after I register, I will immediately discontinue my use of the Archery Range until I am cleared for physical activity by a physician. I agree not to engage in the use of the Archery Range that will result in self-injury. Initial: _____
